SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

October 14, 2019

Mayor Fannin called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m.

Roll call was taken. All members were present except for John Alderson. A quorum was present.

A moment of silence was observed and The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Minutes from the previous meeting will be presented at the next regular council meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

1. **Sewer Repair on Tompkins Avenue** - Mike Szerokman presented a bid from Benchmark Construction Company with an estimated cost between \$25,000 and \$30,000. Mayor Fannin and Mike Szerokman will get 2 additional bids as soon as possible.
2. **Dollar General Sewer Hookup** - Contractor, C.J. Hughes has agreed to do the sewer hookup for Dollar General for \$9,917.00. The town will provide traffic control during the project. Marty Blankenship made a motion to allow the contractor to do the job. Mike Szerokman seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
3. **Unpaid Water Bill Terminations** - Mayor Fannin spoke with Jim Weimer from the PSC about the town's rights to terminate water service for unpaid water bills. Mr. Weimer forwarded information to Mayor Fannin, citing the regulations for terminating water service. Marty Blankenship made a motion to send certified letters of notice to the top ten residents with the most delinquent unpaid bills, then follow the recommended procedure of termination if the bills are still not paid. Continue sending ten notices at a time. Eddie Hamilton seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
4. **Renewal of Suddenlink Contract** - Marty Blankenship made a motion to renew the franchise agreement with Suddenlink. Jay Ward seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

CITIZENS' CONCERNS


Jeff Elswick spoke to the council about his ongoing sewer issue that needs to be resolved. Mayor Fannin agreed to clean out the drain and put a camera in to determine what the problem is and how to fix it.

ADJOURNMENT

Mike Szerokman made a motion to adjourn. Eddie Hamilton seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 8:13 p.m.
