HOUSING BOARD MEETING MINUTES

MARCH 20, 2023

Mayor Fannin called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m.

A moment of silence was observed and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Minutes for the previous meeting were presented for approval. Marty Blankenship made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Dee Leadmon seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Property Updates - 207 ½ 5th Ave is making progress on the demolition. Court orders have been issued for 207 1st Ave. and 128th 5th to be torn down.

Unsafe Structures - Nothing new to report.

Building Permits - Check with new owners at 209 4th Ave. about contractors doing work on the property.

Marmet Code Enforcement Officer - Mayor Fontalbert spoke with Mayor Fannin regarding using their code enforcement officer in other municipalities. The board members discussed hiring the officer to work with Amanda Homes to assist enforcing town ordinances two to three days a week. Mayor Fannin informed the board that the vehicle is marked "Code Enforcement" and that \$20.00 per hour might be a possibility of pay for the officer. Jay Ward suggested that the idea is worth pursuing. Amanda Homes suggested that they could make rounds on Fridays and that a citation book for code enforcement be purchased.

Adjournment - Jay Ward made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Eddie Hamiltob seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 6:58 p.m.
