DISCUSSION

Property 305 ½ 1st Street - Neighbors are complaining about rats and roaches coming from the property. High grass is also an issue. The residence appears to be without water and electricity as well. Will Thornton suggested a visit from the code enforcement officer to determine if citations are needed. The officer can also issue notifications to the health department and other agencies, if warranted. There are other properties in Glasgow which may need to be addressed. Eddie Hamilton made a motion to address properties which may require code enforcement citations and other notifications. Marty Blankenship seconded the motion. Motion carried.

3rd Avenue Wall - Dagwood Blankenship attended the meeting to inform the Housing Board committee that he is seeking legal advice about the situation. Both parties will be asked to attend the next meeting.
