A moment of silence was observed and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.


Minutes for the previous meeting will be presented at the next regular council meeting.

SPECIAL BUSINESS


Sewer Repair on Tompkins Avenue - C.J. Hughes Contracting was the only bidder for the project. The other contractor declined due to the scale of the project. The bid from C.J. Hughes was quoted at \$50,000.00. Due to sewage backing up and into the street, creating a public health hazard, the council decided to hire C.J. Hughes immediately for the project with the following plan: allot \$50,000.00 from the General Fund, John Alderson will set up a meeting with the Kanawha County Commission to seek financial aid, and the town will seek a secured loan from the bank with the town building on Route 60 as collateral. John Alderson made a motion to accept the plan as presented. Dee Leadmon seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Mike Szerokman made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Eddie Hamilton seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 6:40 p.m.
